**DESCRIPTION** (field, expectations, comments):

The Chair for Political Philosophy at the Institute of Philosophy (Warsaw University) engages in educational, research and organizational activities in the field of political philosophy. Educational activities take forms of lectures, tutorials, seminars and translation seminars. The Chair offers also courses on a general university level. The courses offered deal with political philosophy and biopolitics, taking into account the relation of these fields with philosophy of law, history of ideas, social philosophy, philosophy of culture and religion. The research activity of the Chair concentrates on the relation: human-citizen-territory, which constitutes the following research fields: 1. Transformation of the main concepts of political philosophy, 2. The analysis of classical and contemporary philosophical-political thought, 3. The problem of globalization in the framework of political philosophy and of the philosophy of law.

**Expectations from the candidate:**

The characteristics of the research and educational activity of the Chair for Political Philosophy sketched above determines the expectations from the candidates. The candidates are expected to have a record of publications in the field of political philosophy, as well as to be able to run academic courses in Polish and in English in the above described field. Further requirements are: (1) experience of the candidate in organizing conferences, workshops and scientific symposia, (2) experience in international scientific exchange or cooperation with foreign academic centres, (3) experience in cooperation in the framework of international grants, (4) experience in acquiring external research funding. Experience in cooperation with scientific centres researching on political philosophy, biopolitics or philosophy of law will be preferred. The new employee will be expected to develop new scientific and educational initiatives (that is, to develop the Chair's educational offer) and to show organizational skills (to organize international conferences and to apply for scientific grants).

**The candidate is required to:**

1. have a postdoctoral degree in philosophy;
2. have interest and scientific achievements in the following fields: political philosophy, history of ideas, social philosophy;
3. be fluent in foreign languages (above all, English);
4. be able to speak Polish on the level that enables holding academic lectures;
5. have organizational experience (organization of conferences, symposia and workshops);

- 6. have experience in running academic courses in philosophy;**
- 7. have a record of contacts with foreign scientific centres (academic exchange, publications also in foreign languages);**
- 8. have a record of high standard scientific publications.**

The candidate must fulfil requirements specified in Art. 114 paragraph 5 of the Act on Academic Education of 27 July 2005, Official Journal No. 164 item 1365 with further changes (Dz. U. z 2016 poz. 1842) and § 88 (1) point 4 of the Statute of UW dated 7<sup>th</sup> July 2015
