DESCRIPTION:

The Department of Ethics of the Institute of Philosophy, the University of Warsaw, conducts research in the traditional subdisciplines of ethics and interdisciplinary research on contemporary ethical issues. The research relies on the methods of humanities, history of ideas, theory of value, and social science. The specific topics of research include: (1) normative ethics (classical ethical theories, normativity, practical deliberation, justification of moral beliefs, relationship between normative theory and moral practice, moral motivation, intention, moral certainty, moral error and failure); (2) bioethics (informed consent to medical intervention, ethics of transplantations, the ethical aspects of human embodiment, risks and benefits for biomedical research participant, medically assisted reproduction, clinical ethical consultation, environmental ethics, the ethical foundations of bioethical regulations); (3) social ethics (justice, equality, human dignity and human rights, the ethics of public life, tolerance, solidarity, political community); (4) applied ethics (professional ethics, the ethics of new technologies, philosophy of medicine).

The Department teaches students of the following courses of studies: philosophy, bioethics, and cognitive science. The subjects taught include: general ethics, history of ethical ideas, social ethics, and bioethics. Various courses are also taught at other organisational units of the University of Warsaw.

Requirements:

Candidates will be evaluated in compliance with the requirements of the Statute of the University of Warsaw, the European Charter for Researchers and the guidelines of the Rector of the University of Warsaw regarding recruitment of junior teacher-researchers for the Assistant position. In order to facilitate the recruitment committee's evaluation process in compliance with the documents mentioned above, Candidates are requested

to complete the survey form (attached) regarding their previous research and teaching activities.

Candidates must hold a PhD in philosophy or MA in philosophy (if the PhD thesis has been submitted and approved by the supervisor) and academic record that corresponds to the research profile of the Department of Ethics. Candidates' scholarly interests must be directly related to at least two fields of research conducted in the Department (see 1-4 above). The ability and motivation for team work is necessary. International scholarly achievements and organizational skills will constitute significant assets.

Candidates should provide evidence of their interests, accomplishments, and skills with publications, conference presentations, and participation in research projects (see the survey).

A successful candidate will be able and prepared to teach courses on ethics and introduction to philosophy, as well as at least one of the following subjects: introduction to bioethics, environmental ethics, the ethics of new technologies (detailed information is provided in the USOS system). The candidate will also have the command of both Polish and English sufficient for teaching at the University level of education.

Requirements:

- 1. PhD in philosophy diploma; alternatively, MA in philosophy diploma and proof of submission of the PhD dissertation in philosophy and supervisor's approval);
- 2. evidence of academic record (such as conference presentations or publications) in normative ethics, bioethics, social ethics, or applied ethics;
- 3. evidence (such as qualification documents or certificates, or course evaluation sheet) of competencies necessary for teaching ethics and introduction to philosophy, as well as at least one of the following subjects: introduction to bioethics, environmental ethics, the ethics of new technologies;
- 4. evidence (such as certificates or accomplishments or documentation of courses taught or diploma work) of the command of English sufficient for teaching philosophical topics at the University level of education;
- 5. foreigners: evidence (such as certificates or accomplishments or documentation of courses taught or diploma work) of the command of Polish sufficient for teaching philosophical topics at the University level of education;
- 6. organisational experience, e.g. organisation of conferences, symposia, workshops, work for scientific societies etc.

- 5) A copy of the PhD diploma in philosophy; alternatively a copy of the MA diploma in philosophy together with the proof of submission of PhD dissertation in philosophy and the supervisor's approval);
- 6) Evidence of the scholarly achievements required and evidence of the didactic, linguistic, and organizational qualifications and competencies.
- 7) Certificate of employment, if applicable.
