ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR (*ADIUNKT*) at the Centre for European Regional and Local Studies (*EUROREG*)

holding a PhD degree/habilitation in social sciences or humanities

Applicants must fulfil the conditions laid down in the Act on Higher Education of 27 July 2005 (Journal of Law from 2017, No. 2183 with subsequent amendments) and in the Statute of the University of Warsaw.

Requirements:

- a PhD in social sciences or humanities;
- a habilitation degree will be an advantage;
- publications in the field of interdisciplinary urban studies, including publications in English;
- experience in international research in the field of urban studies;
- extensive experience in popularising science and in cooperation with public institutions and audiences outside of the university;
- experience in the organisation of international academic conferences;
- excellent command of Polish and English and the ability to teach in Polish and English;
- teaching experience (also international);

Applicants should submit the following documents:

- letter of application;
- completed personal information form;
- certified copy of PhD/habilitation degree diploma;
- curriculum vitae;
- summary of research, teaching and organisational achievements;
- list of published work;
- other relevant information and documents demonstrating the applicant's interests and qualifications;
- declaration that the University of Warsaw shall be the place of primary employment for the applicant within the meaning defined in the Act on Higher Education of 27 July 2005;
- for applicants making submissions by email – the documents must be sent as PDF files, with the applicant's name and the advertised position in the title of the file.

Note: the application should include the following declaration: *I hereby agree to the processing of my personal particulars included in my job offer insofar as this may be necessary in the*

recruitment process (pursuant to the Personal Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997, consolidated text: Dziennik Ustaw 2016 item 922)

The competition is the first stage of the procedure of employment as an academic teacher - specified in the Statute of the University of Warsaw - and its positive result is the basis for further proceedings.
