**CONTRA will hire 15 PhD students**, each located and supervised at one of the participating universities. CONTRA will provide training in computational cancer research and professional software development, for analysis of novel experimental data including but not limited to single-cell genomics data.

**CONTRA** is an EU funded Innovative Training Network consisting of 8 principal investigators from equally many major European universities :

- The Royal institute of Technology (KTH, Coordinator), Stockholm;
- The University of Cambridge;
- ETH Zurich;
- University of Warsaw;
- University of Vigo;
- King’s College London and the Francis Crick Institute (KCL/Crick);
- Institute for Research in Biomedicine (IRB), Barcelona;
- The Institute of Cancer Research, ICR London.

as well as partners from pharmaceutical, biotech-start up, and software development companies.

CONTRA will provide interdisciplinary and intersectorial training enabling the next generation of computational cancer biologists to lead developments across the application triangle of pharmaceutical, biotech and software industry.

The program will last 36 months.
