Announces a competition for the position of a Postdoctoral Research Fellow for the study of representations of religious pluralism from the Jewish perspective within the Horizon 2020 project RETOPEA – Religious Toleration and Peace

Conditions of employment: full-time, fixed term (24 months), number of positions – 1

Place of employment: Faculty of 'Artes Liberales', University of Warsaw

Position characteristics: the successful candidate will be given the opportunity to analyse the representations of religious pluralism included mostly in the museum exhibitions dedicated to the Jewish history. This research will be carried out in close relation to the Work Package 3 of the project and will include the study of museums and centres in, i.a., Warsaw, Berlin, Skopje, Granada, Toledo and Brussels. The candidate will be expected to closely collaborate with other members of the project, in particular with those associated directly with WP3; travel to the above mentioned institutions and carry out research on site; present research results during the project meetings and at the relevant scientific conferences; deliver in a timely manner reports to be used further by other project partners; and publish research results related to the project in relevant international scholarly journals.

The successful candidate will meet the following criteria:

- ♦ PhD in history, literary studies, art history or cultural studies;
- Excellent knowledge of English and at least one more modern language; knowledge of Hebrew and/or Yiddish welcome;
- Experience in scholarly work in other domestic and international research centres;
- Experience in scholarly work within research teams;
- Publications in renowned academic journals and publishing houses documenting research experience in the field of history, cultural anthropology, Jewish studies, theory and analysis of museum exhibitions;
- Experience in presenting papers at and organizing international conferences and seminars;
- Capacity to act in law;
- ♦ Clean criminal record;
- ♦ Clean academic teaching ban record.

The applications will be subject to consideration by the Competition Commission appointed by the Dean of the Faculty of 'Artes Liberales' of the University of Warsaw. The Commission may invite selected candidates for interview. The competition will be adjudicated by the 27<sup>th</sup> of April 2018. The predicted date of employment is: no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of June 2018. The competition is the first stage of a recruitment procedure of an academic teacher hiring procedure described in the University of Warsaw's Statute and its positive result is a basis for further proceedings. The candidates will be notified about the result of the competition by email.
